Who is the course for?

The Greater Manchester Training Hub invites NMC registered nurses who are newly qualified within the last 12 months holding a salaried role within general practice.

It is a programme of support for nurses to take up substantive roles, understand the context they are working in, become embedded in the PCN, and retain practice nurses for the primary care workforce.

What does the course cover?

2 year structured programme with salary support to practice for 1x session per week.

Phase 1 (Support & Networking): Transition into general practice, allocation of GPN supervisor, introduction to peer networks	Phase 1 (Support & Networking): Peer support, supervision & coaching.
Phase 2 (Learning & Development) : Access to Foundation in General Practice Nursing course for clinical skills modules	Phase 2 (Learning & Development): inclusive of Quality improvement, practice management skills & remote consultation.
Phase 3 (PCN Portfolio working) : Personalised PDP and intro to PCN	Phase 3: PCN Portfolio working
